- Develop a neighborhood Safety & Preparedness Plan and discuss it as a group on a regular basis. Check in with KSRG for templates and other suggestions.
- Always remember that Rule #1 in any crisis is: **STAY CALM**. Practice your plan, talk with everyone who may be involved on a regular basis, and keep in mind that we will all need to lend a hand to help keep our community safe and resilient.
